6 Update on Hanham Common Pavilion, football pitches and goal posts

Clerk updated the committee on the current hire agreements in place for the forthcoming season. Old Georgians will have two teams playing on a Saturday. The warden warned that we may wish to restrict any further hires to ensure the pitch stays in good condition throughout the season.

Old Georgians reported the goal posts are unstable and require attention. Clerk instructed Steve Burbidge to inspect goal posts and fit brackets to support the corner joints.

7 SGC Street Cleaning & Maintenance Work in the Parish – top 5 jobs

Clerk presented list of jobs that have been collated from all parish councillors. Clerk to send list of Dave Jones at SGC. Any that cannot be completed will be reported to the council as needing attention.

- Court Farm Rd - verges and hedges are very overgrown along this stretch of road
- Abbots Road from Crossleaze to Stephens Green - verges and hedges overgrown, graffiti on road 'stop sign' by Stephens green
- Common Rd from Memorial Rd - Verges the length of this road need clearing
- The Cycle Lane/path adjacent to the ring road from Stonehill to Abbots Road to Hicks gate – the fence needs repairs at various points - graffiti by rail bridge removed and white line on cycle path repainted
- The Chevron signs at the entrance to Hanham Court have been damaged and need replacing – the cat eyes have also been tarmac'd over on the road.
